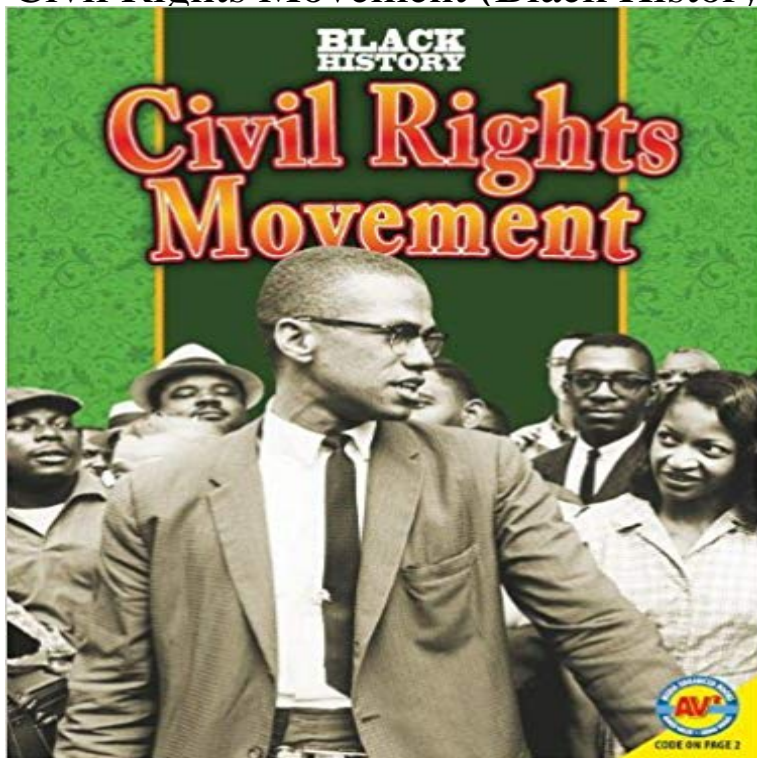


## Civil Rights Movement (Black History)
