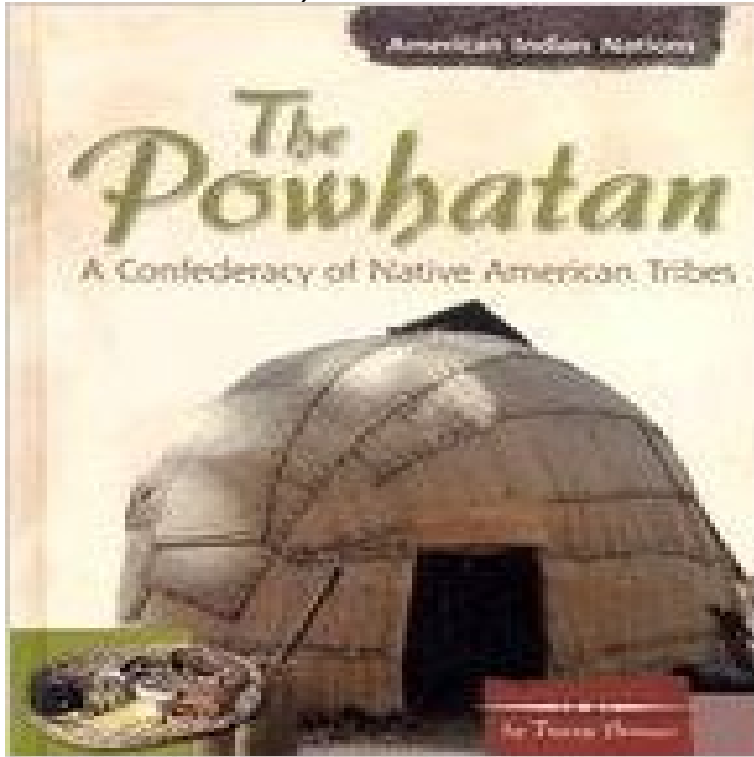


The Powhatan: A Confederacy of Native American Tribes (American Indian Nations)
