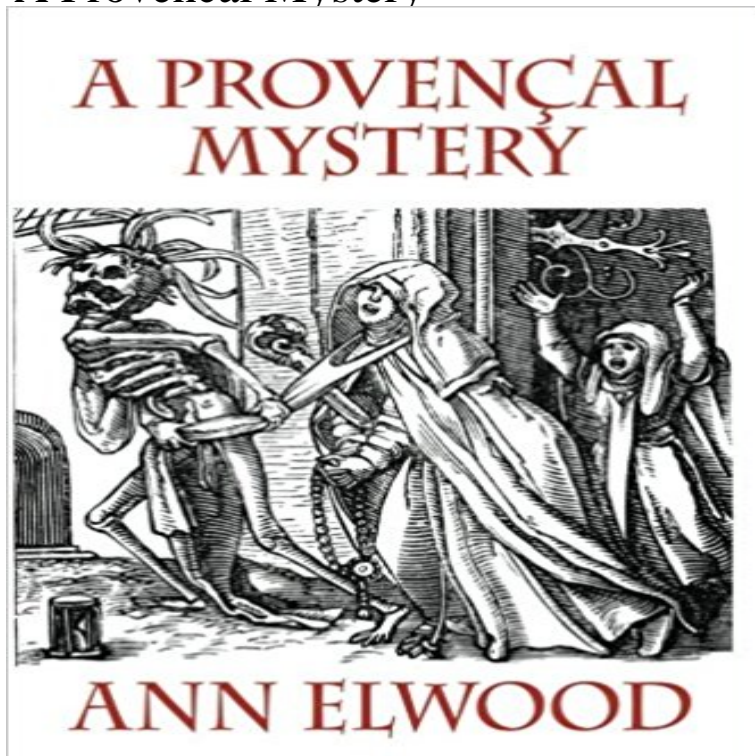


A Provençal Mystery
