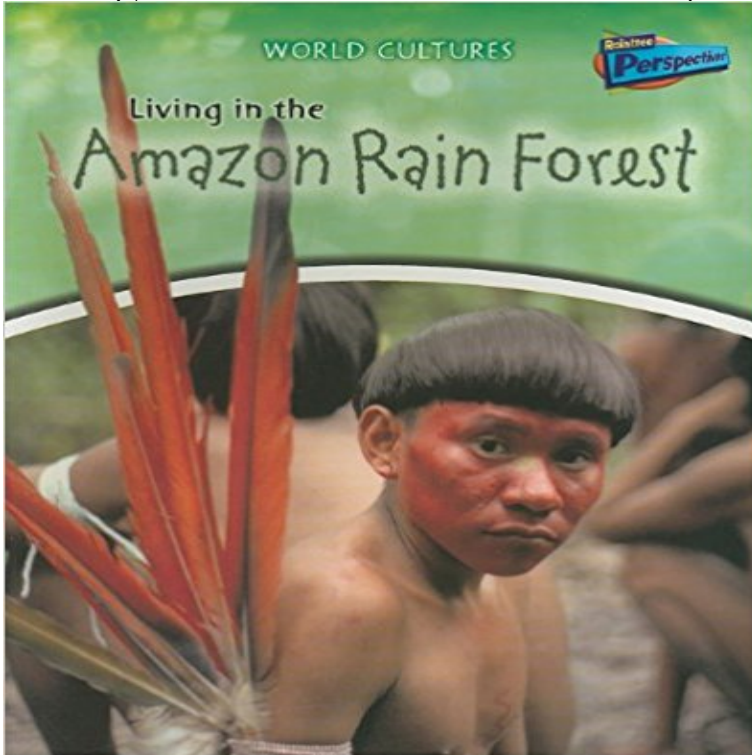


Living in the Amazon Rain Forest (World Cultures)
