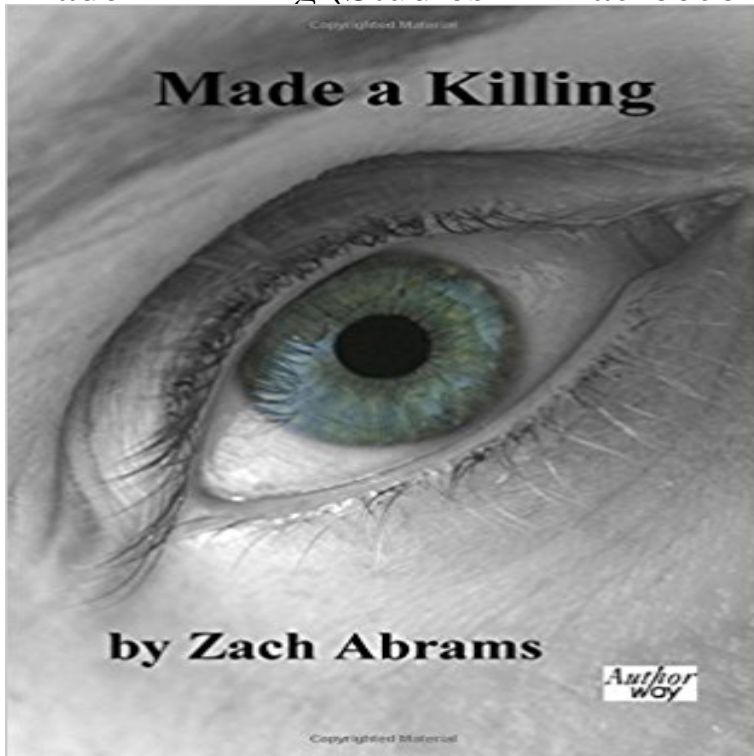


## Made A Killing (Studies in Macroeconomic History)



The first of a new Scottish crime series that you have to read. A fast moving, gripping crime novel set in the tough crime-ridden streets of Glasgow. Scott Stevenson was a despicable character and nobody mourns when his bloody corpse is found with an ivory tusk driven through his torso. DCI Alex Warren and his team are given the challenging task of discovering his killer. They investigate the numerous people Stevenson has harmed and their enquiries reveal a host of related crimes, motivated by sex and greed. Away from the crime investigation, theres family drama as well as a touch of romance and more than a sprinkling of humour. Readers familiar

with the geography of Scotland and Glasgow in particular can associate with the area as the detectives tread their weary path on their way to researching the crimes and solving the mystery. In addition Zach Abrams is the author of two financial crime thrillers, Ring Fenced and Source and he has co-written Twists and Turns an anthology of short stories.
