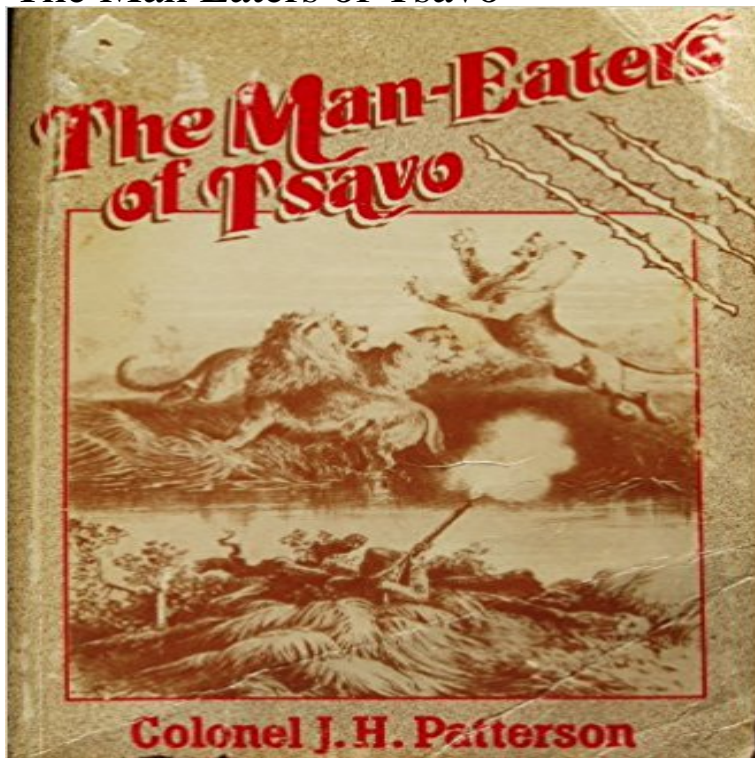


The Man Eaters of Tsavo



The Man-eaters of Tsavo and other East African Adventures is a book written by Col. John Henry Patterson in 1907 about a pair of man-eating lions that he was hired to hunt down and kill to protect railway workers in Kenya. The lions became known as the Tsavo man-eaters. The book describes attacks by two man-eating lions on the builders of the Uganda Railway in Tsavo, Kenya in 1898 and how the lions killed nearly 140 people in less than a year. Col. Patterson was hired by the railway to hunt down and kill the lions. The book has been adapted to film three times: a monochrome, British film of the 1950s, a 1952 3-D film titled *Bwana Devil*, and a 1996 color version called *The Ghost and the Darkness*, where Val Kilmer played the daring engineer who hunts down the lions of Tsavo.
