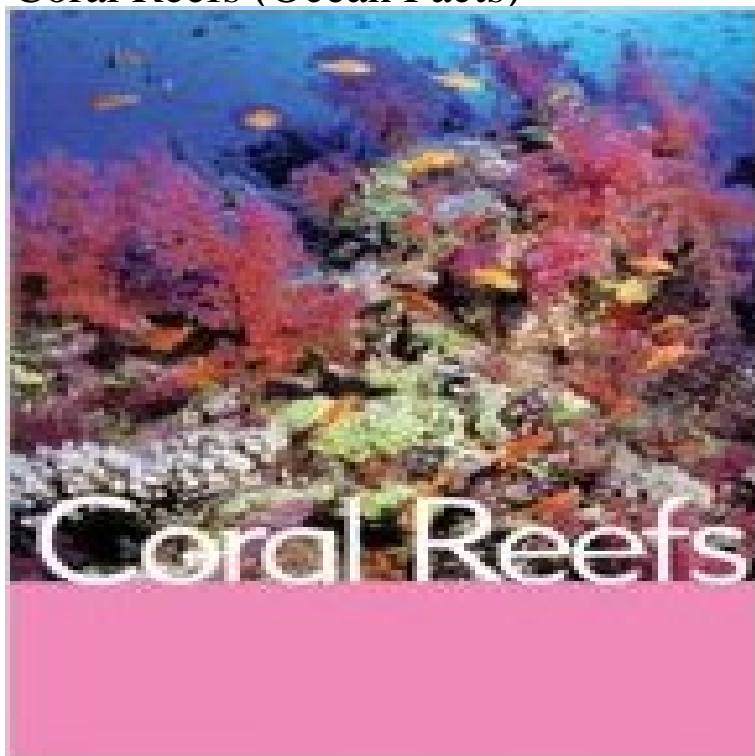


Coral Reefs (Ocean Facts)
