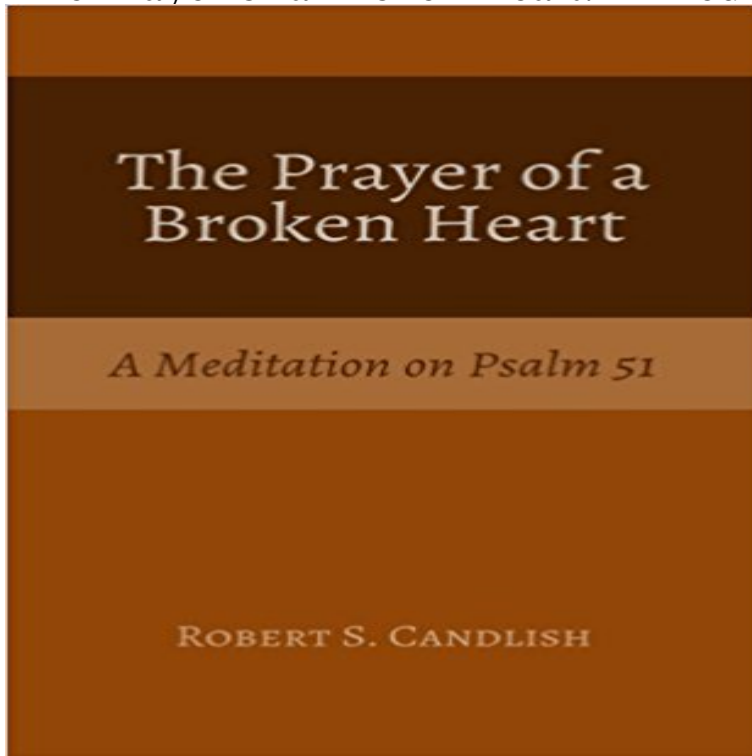


The Prayer of a Broken Heart: A Meditation on Psalm 51
