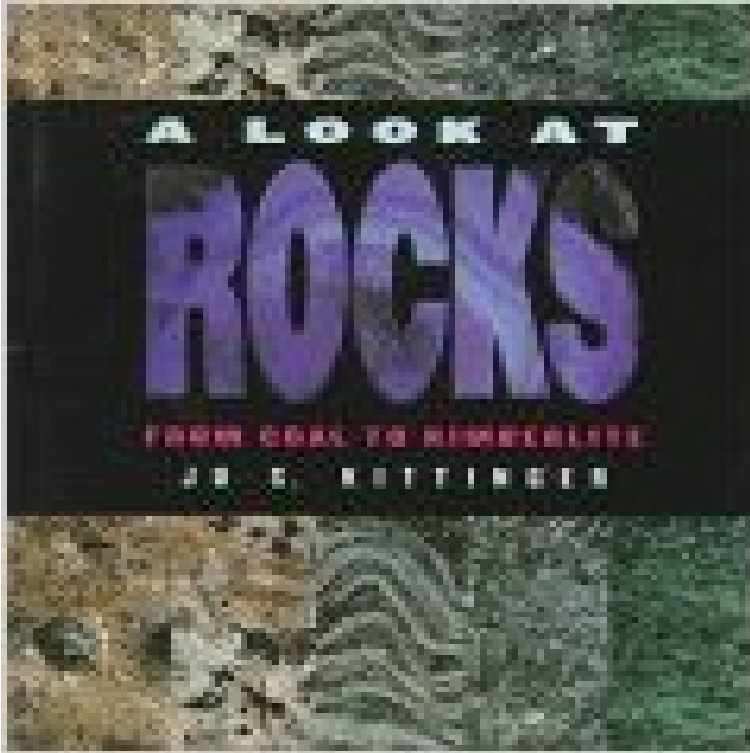


A Look at Rocks (First Books--Earth & Sky Science)
