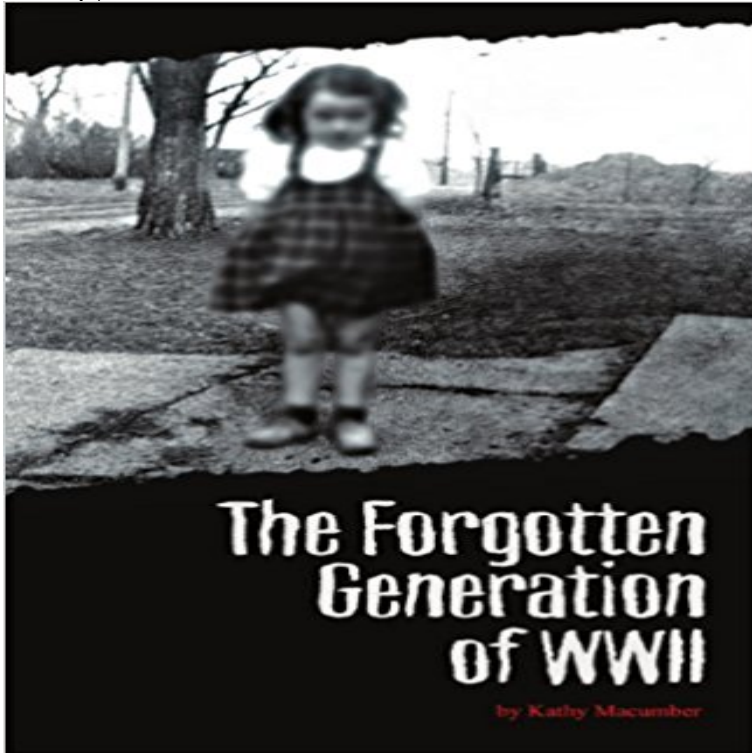


Forgotten Generation of WWII
