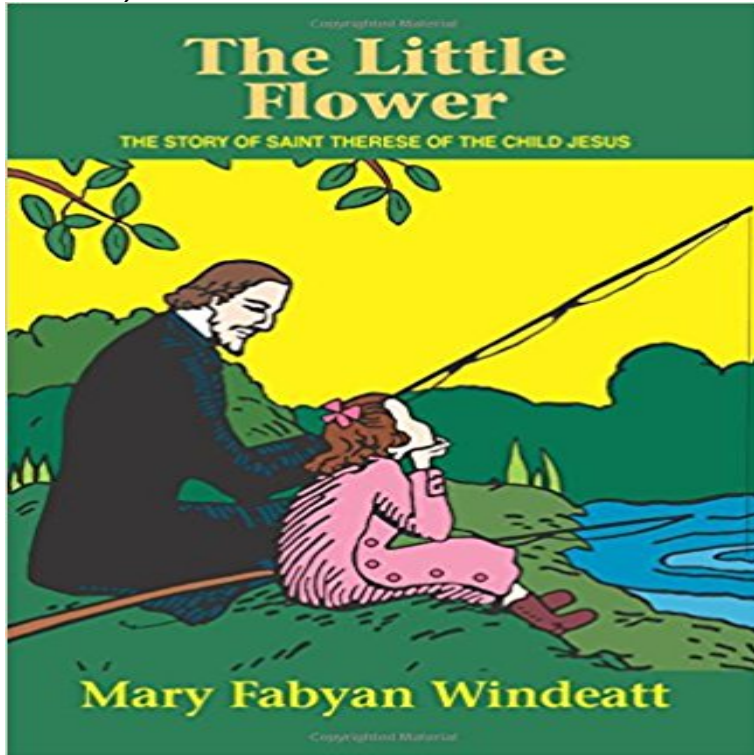


## The Little Flower: The Story of St. Therese of the Child Jesus (Saints Lives)
