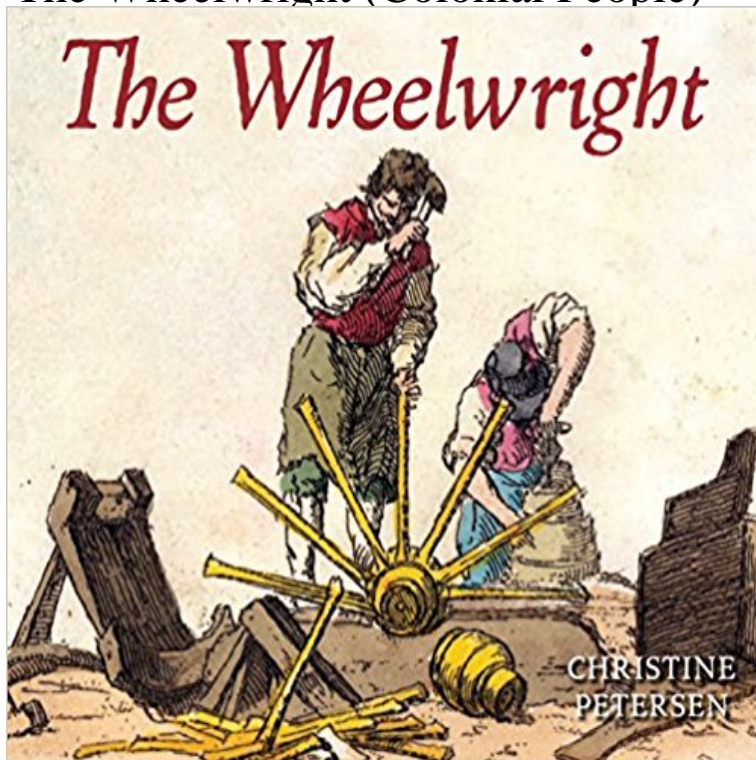


## The Wheelwright (Colonial People)
